The Forum's area of work reflect the decisions of the BRICS Xiamen Declaration (2017), in which the leaders of the BRICS countries committed themselves to stimulate research and development, increase the availability of drugs, including low-cost segment, vaccines, diagnostics, cost reduction of medical services, by means of increase of financial support and through the improvement of the health care system. It is stated in the Declaration that the knowledge and experience of traditional medicine should be scientifically studied for the implementation of research, development and innovation in solving the problems of health care system.

The Forum will bring together the leading scientists and practitioners from BRICS countries, in order to adopt proportionate and coordinated approaches to promote effective communication

and exchange of knowledge, experience and competencies between practitioners of traditional medicine and modern medicine, in accordance with the provisions of the Xiamen Declaration.

"The Forum is designed to strengthen the interstate exchange of best practices and to harmonize regulation in health care systems, – the Forum's President Sergey V. Kalashnikov, First Deputy Chairman of the Federation Council Committee on Economic Policy commented. - "The Forum's agenda includes the exchange of information on achievements in the field of medical technologies, development of approaches to the integration of the world's traditional medical systems into national health care systems, especially in the field of preventive medicine, strengthening the cooperation in education and research".
